## Quilting Basics & Techniques

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### Beginning Quilt Making

Step 1: A machine pieced quilt top. In this class we make a sampler quilt top of 9 different blocks, blending time honored skills with updated tools and techniques. Basic quilt making covers the topics of supplies, tools and fabric, rotary cutting, machine piecing, quilt top construction, border application and binding. Our class will discuss quilting options for Step 2 — finishing your sampler quilt top. Join us to help develop skills, achieve accurate results and increase confidence in quilting.

### Intermediate Quilt Making

Fabric purchase and limited cutting are done prior to the class.

You can choose to make either the Nova or Valerie quilt by GE Designs. Other GE patterns may be used if it uses the Stripology Squared ruler.

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### Chenille Baby Quilt

### Meadowland

### **Kentucky Spirits Judy Niemeyer Quilt** **All Levels**

This 99" Square Judy Niemeyer quilt continues the tradition of a beautiful medallion quilt. Spacing the class weeks apart gives you plenty of time to work on each technique. Your certified instructor Julie Arrowood will walk you through the steps of construction each month, making what seems difficult into easy construction steps. Make an appointment in advance to get your fabric selections in place and purchased. An heirloom for any home!

### **Diamonds in the Sky Quilt** **All Levels**

The blocks in this quilt give an alternating diamond illusion. With the Corner Beam ruler, you'll quickly cut the needed shapes from strips and squares. The ruler makes it easy to achieve perfect points. Choose a light or dark background to create a brilliant high contrast quilt. We'll make four corner beam units and sew them together in one block to get you started on this beautiful quilt. Fabric Kits like the store sample are available.

### **Easy Street Crib Quilt** **All Levels**

The Folded Corner Clipper is a quilter's "must have" ruler. Make folded corners quickly and accurately – no need to draw pencil lines! The "folded corner" is used in a variety of blocks; diamond in a square, snowball, flying geese, and cornered rectangles. It can also be used to cut perfect 45° angles to cut binding strips. In this class you will learn the basics of the Folded Corner Clipper and use your new skills to make the Easy Street Baby Quilt. Fabric Kits similar to the store sample are available.

### **Sew Simple Pineapple Quilt** **All Levels**

Both types of jelly rolls are available for making this lap-size heirloom quilt.

### **Wingman Organizer** **All Levels**

### **Easy Mitred Placemat** **All Levels**

### **Tubing it Pillowcase** **All Levels**

Finished case measures approx. 6 in x 13 in This case is also an excellent way to transport a mini iron to class or a retreat. Silicone insert is 100% food grade silicone and heat resistant up to 450 degrees. Refill silicone inserts available.

## Class Supply Lists and Other Information

- For each class there is a list of supplies needed. Please stop in to pick up a supply list for each class you register for. Supply lists are also available over the phone. All supplies needed for classes will be available at the shop.
- If a class requires a sewing machine, make sure your machine is in good working order. This will save you a lot of frustration in the long run.
- Quilt classes are generally for the top only. Help with finishing your quilt is always available at the store and classes on finishing will be available periodically.
- Try to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of class so you will have time to get your supplies organized and purchase any additional supplies you may need.
- Wash your fabrics prior to class. This will prevent bleeding or shrinkage of your finished product.
- In consideration of classmates, children should not accompany you to class.

## Whats New

Now that Christmas is over, your time is more your own. Perhaps a quilt project will help the long winter nights. We have a great offering of fun projects and techniques.
