# Quilting Basics & Techniques

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### Beginning Quilt Making

Do you want to learn how to make a quilt top with your sewing machine or sharpen your basic skills? Join us for the Beginning Quilt Making class. In this class we make a sampler quilt top of 9 different blocks. We use Lori Holt's Farm Girl Vintage book for our class. The topics that are covered include: how to select fabric, accurate seam allowance, rotary cutting, most commonly used piecing techniques and finishings. No prework is required. We will discuss fabric selection and required tools in the first class.

### Machine Quilting with Rulers All Levels

Use rulers on your sewing machine with your free motion quilting to expand your quilting beyond stippling. In this class, we will explore motifs using the Angela Walters rulers from Creative Grids. Quilt free motion in the ditch, fill a block, embellish a border or try an all-over design using these rulers and you will add an elegant look more commonly seen from long-arm quilting. We will demonstrate ruler use, how to use the ruler markings, and get you started with quilting designs. Students must know how to set up their machine for free-motion and have previous machine quilting experience.

### Curvy Log Cabin Ruler

In this class you will learn how to use the Curvy Log Cabin ruler from Creative Grids. This ruler makes the Zen Table Runner super fast and easy to create. Only 2 fabrics are required and you can make your table runner in either arrangement from the pattern. This table runner uses the 8" curvy log cabin ruler. If you have the 6" or 4" curvy log cabin ruler, you can make the same blocks in a smaller size. We will cover tips and tricks for the ruler. Kits like the store sample are available.

### Machine Quilting

Too many quilt tops and not enough time? Tired of machine quilting "in the ditch"? Well, drop those feed dogs and take off with all the lovely quilting stencils that you really want to use. This hands-on class will focus on freehand quilting with information and demonstrations of quilting with a darning foot, nylon thread and various other specialty threads. Proper techniques for quilting full sized quilts will also be discussed. Students must know how to remove, cover or lower feed dogs and must have a darning foot.

### Beginning Paper Piecing

This is a basic tool most quilters should learn. Some blocks will be easier using this technique and/or you may eye a pattern you like using this technique. To learn the basics, you will be picking a miniature pattern to produce. Many options are available, and kits are also an option. By the end of the class, you will have the basics required to tackle even the most difficult projects.

### Lil Twister Technique Class

**All Levels**

This acrylic tool allows you to piece pinwheels using 5in squares of fabric. Perfect for charm packs. In the class you will be learning to use the tool making a 15" x 21" table topper. After learning the basics, the owners of the tool have created many options for you to use the tool in quilts, bags, and runners. Come in and see the store sample, then decide what you will be using!

### Diamonds in the Sky

The blocks in this quilt give an alternating diamond illusion. With the Corner Beam ruler, you'll quickly cut the needed shapes from strips and squares. The ruler makes it easy to achieve perfect points. Choose a light or dark background to create a brilliant high contrast quilt. We'll make four corner beam units and sew them together in one block to get you started on this beautiful quilt.

### Lemoyne Star Technique

A traditional Lemoyne star is noted for its difficulty. Using Deb tucker's tool has made this block easy for anyone. We will be making just one block, but the ruler has a pattern for a wall-hanging if you wish to make something larger. Learn how to take all the stress out of this block!

- If a class requires a sewing machine, make sure your machine is in good working order. This will save you a lot of frustration in the long run.
- Quilt classes are generally for the top only. Help with finishing your quilt is always available at the store and classes on finishing will be available periodically.
- Try to arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of class so you will have time to get your supplies organized and purchase any additional supplies you may need.
- Wash your fabrics prior to class. This will prevent bleeding or shrinkage of your finished product.
- In consideration of classmates, children should not accompany you to class.


We will be starting a new Block of the month in January. It is called Tonga Plum Fusion and measures 108" Square. The Plum Fusion quilt is composed of twelve-monthly blocks sashed with star accent corners. The pretty on-point setting is finished off with large 12" hourglass that create large corner star points. As with all our block of the months, we price the kits based on how much fabric is in them.

**We are only taking 24 signups, so don't wait too long!**
